

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUATION IN, OR TERMINATION FROM, ACADEMIC PROGRAMS, AND A POLICY FOR READMISSION OF STUDENTS WHO ARE DISQUALIFIED FOR ACADEMIC REASONS

Rudolf Steiner College may place students on academic probation if their overall work is less than satisfactory and they fail to make adequate academic progress. Students may be dismissed when their overall work is so poor as to result in failure to graduate in a timely fashion.

Students who have been dismissed for academic reasons may be considered for reinstatement through a petition process submitted to the Academic Affairs Committee through the Dean of Students or Academic Dean. They may also apply for re-admission after one year.

Students who have been dismissed for disciplinary reasons may re-apply for admission to the College after one year, accompanied by a petition for re-admission to the Academic Affairs Committee. The petition must satisfactorily address the reason for dismissal.
